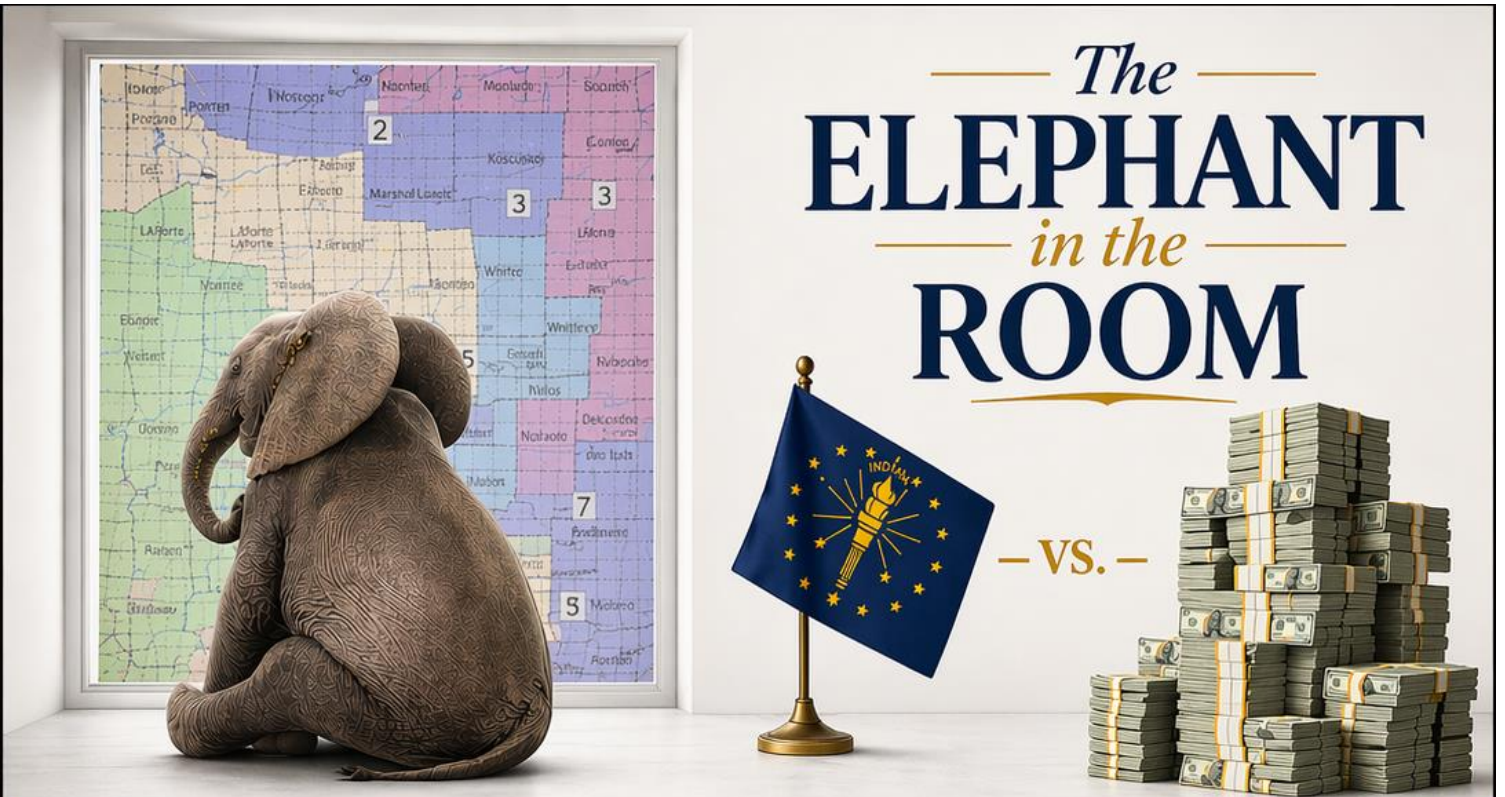


# The ELEPHANT in the ROOM
